### Potomac River Yacht Clubs Association 2009 FLOAT-IN July 17-19 2009

**For:** Member Clubs of the Potomac River Yacht Clubs Association and Guests.

**Date and Location:** Scheduled for the weekend of **17 July through 19 July**. Boats may arrive starting at 1000 on Friday and the Float-In will officially end at 1400 on Sunday. The event will be at the **Kinsale Marina and the Moorings Restaurant in Kinsale, VA.**



**Registration:** Registrations will be accepted not earlier than **6 April 2009 at 1830**. This time coincides with the start of the annual **Commodore's Night at Mount Vernon Yacht Club**. Registration may also be mailed to: Mr. Frank Erwetowski, 11420 Mohawk Court, Swan Point, MD 20645-2146. Mailed registration packages received on or before 6 April will be dated 7 April (for registration purposes).

**Club-based registrations are encouraged; however, individual registration will be accepted.** Slip assignments will be based on vessel size, power need and registration date, every effort will be made to keep club boats together. Each vessel will have a minimum of one (1) 30 Amp power connections. Additional 30 Amp or 50 Amp connections may be available.

Registration packages are due to the PRYCA Treasurer no later than 1 July 2009. Individual checks made payable to "PRYCA" for the total registration cost of each boat and all persons (Adults & Children) should be assembled and forwarded with the registration forms. **A completed reservation must identify the club, the club point of contact, a minimum of three (3) people to assist with registration/sales/games and assist with vessel docking.** Club checks will not be accepted.

**Cancellation and Refunds:** Notice of all cancellations must be made to the PRYCA Treasurer (Frank Erwetowski) E-mail: [fpge@comcast.net](mailto:fpge@comcast.net). No refund of Registration Fees will be made for cancellations received after 10 July. Paid Slip Fees may be refunded on a case-by-case basis for personal, medical and mechanical emergencies as long as the Association is not held responsible for the fees.

**Costs:**

1. **Slip Fees:** **\$1.50** per foot per night plus **\$4.00** per 30-Amp power cord or **\$8.00** per 50 Amp power cord per night.

2. **Registration Fee:** **\$80.00** per person age 13 and older, **\$30.00** per child under 12 years old, children 4 and under are free.

**Operations:** Vessels may arrive on Friday, 17 July after 1000 to get slip assignments. When approaching the marina, hail PRYCA on channel 09 to obtain a working channel. You will be provided a slip assignment and dockhands will meet you at your assigned slip to assist with docking.

Pick up your "Welcome Package" upon arrival. These will be available until 1700 both Friday and Saturday. If you arrive after 1700, it is suggested you have a club member pick up your Welcome Package prior to registration closing for the day.

**Prizes:** One raffle ticket for each registered individual will be in your boat's Welcome Package. These tickets will be used for door prize drawings on Saturday evening. You must be present to win.

Throughout the weekend, 50/50 raffle tickets will be sold. The 50/50 raffle ticket will be drawn and the prize awarded during the Saturday evening dinner/dance. You must be present to win.

Throughout the weekend "**big prize**" raffle tickets will be sold. The "**big prize**" will also be drawn during the Saturday evening dinner/dance. **You must be present to win.**

**Objectives:** We expect at least 75 boats at this year's Float-In. Our goal is to have a fun filled weekend for all. Please realize that boats range in size from 20 to 60 feet and the docks are constrained by size. We will make every effort to keep clubs together. However, we anticipate some clubs may be split due to slip sizes and availability constraints.

Determine Slip Fee:

Length of boat x **\$1.50** = Slip fee + **\$4.00** per 30 amp or **\$8.00** for each 50 amp = Nightly Boat Cost.  
 Multiply Nightly Boat Cost x number of nights circled—enter total in Total Boat Cost.

Determine Registration Fee:

Multiply number of adults (age 13 and older) x **\$80.00** = Registration cost of adults.  
 Multiply number of children (under 12) x **\$30.00** = Registration cost of children.  
 Add Registration cost of adults plus Registration cost of children –enter sum in Total People Cost

Determine Total Registration Cost:

Add Total Boat Cost and Total People Cost equals
